ON THE LEGAL AUDIT PROCESS

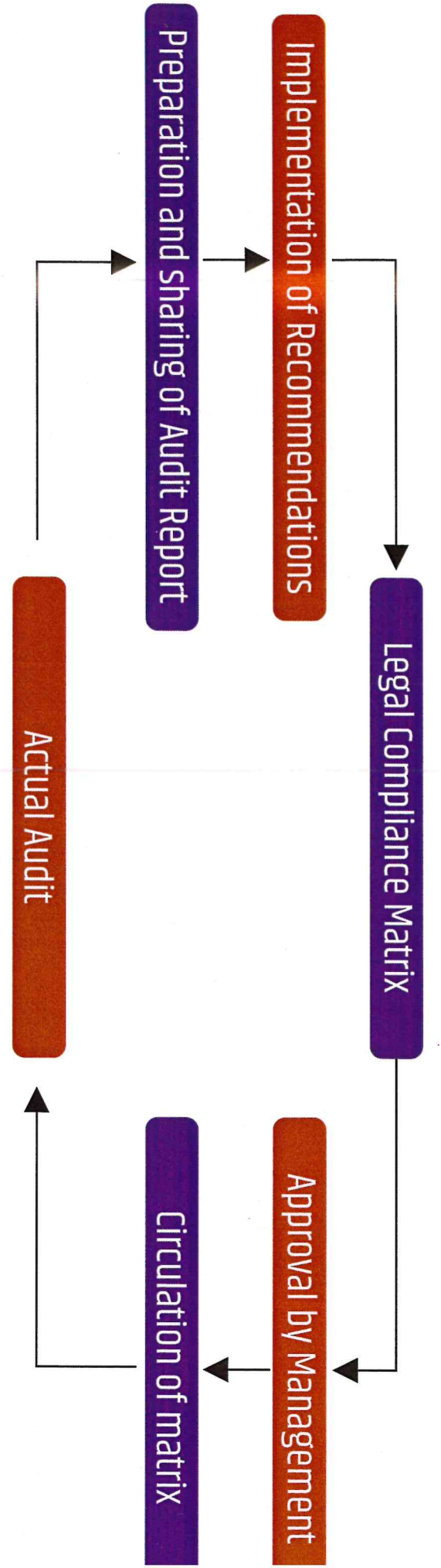
1. What is a legal audit?

Legal audit is an evaluation of compliance with laws and regulations that are pertinent to an organization's operations.

2. Why is a legal audit necessary?

Legal audit assesses an institution's level of compliance with relevant laws and regulations.

4. What are some of the pertinent issues we look at during the audit?

Licensing, Fair Administrative Action, Data Protection, Access to Information, Occupational Safe and Health, Ethics and Values of Public Officers, Work Related Injuries and Informed Consent

5. Frequency of Audit

Once every year.

6. What next after a legal audit?

A detailed report capturing the findings of the audit and recommendations is prepared and submitted to management for approval and implementation.
